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Policy

Jordan University Hospital is committed to ensure proper and safe administration of contrast media to all patients.

Purpose:

To establish guidelines that will ensure proper conduct by all employees regarding injection of any contrast media or medication.

Definitions:

CT: CT scan

MRI: Magnetic resonance imaging IVU: Intravenous urethrogram

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Equipment /Forms

Procedure	Responsibility
 No employee shall administer any type of radiological contrast, except oral contrast media, unless ordered and supervised by radiology resident or radiology consultant. Radiology technologist shall ensure that proper contrast media is being used by: Reading the labels at time of drawing from hospital stock Reading the labels before drawing media into a syringe or connecting tubing for a drip The technician must be fully aware of the labels before proceeding with the injection. Any violation of the above policy by any employee will result in serious disciplinary action 	Radiology Consultant Radiology resident Radiology technologist

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General Rules
